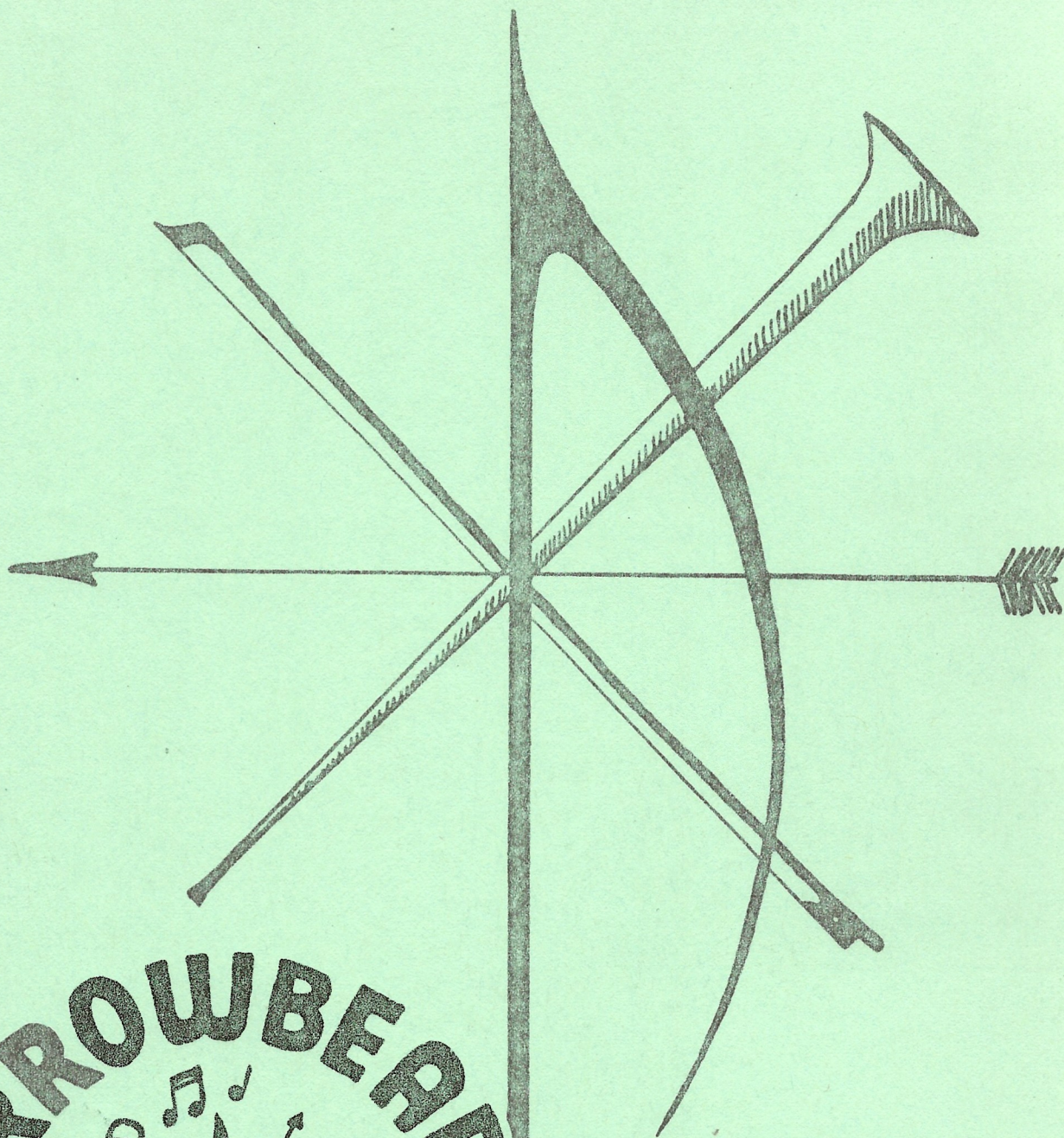

In 1937 FRED OHLENDORF came to the Long Beach Unified School District as a music teacher. That first year he organized an All-District Orchestra. Previously he was a teacher of music in Chicago Heights, Illinois. "Mr O" as he is affectionately called, received his education at Northwestern University where he played violin and viola. In 1959 he became Music Consultant for the Long Beach Unified School District from which he retired in 1970. For forty six years Mr Ohlendorf has presented concerts with the All-District Orchestras consisting of Junior and Senior High School students. He has been honored continually for his efforts on behalf of the youth of Southern California. He is a man who has brought beautiful music, to the ears of many and who has brought out the musical talents in many which might have gone unrecognized.

EDNA OHLENDORF works behind the scenes around the year to keep Arrowbear going - answering phone calls, responding to letters and being responsible for the organizational details. Her generous and cheerful spirit is always felt and greatly appreciated by all who come in contact with her. Mrs Ohlendorf earned a Bachelor of Music Degree in Piano Performance (Cum Laude) from USC. She spent many years giving private piano lessons in Long Beach. She is a member of the Mu Ihi Epsilon Fraternity, the Musical Arts Club and an honorary member of the Music Teachers Association of California, Long Beach Branch.

DENNIS DOCKSTADER is Camp Manager and lives here in the mountains with his wife Carole and their three children. He is on the faculty at CSUSB and teaches at CEDU, a private school which deals with students who have problems adjusting to conventional education. 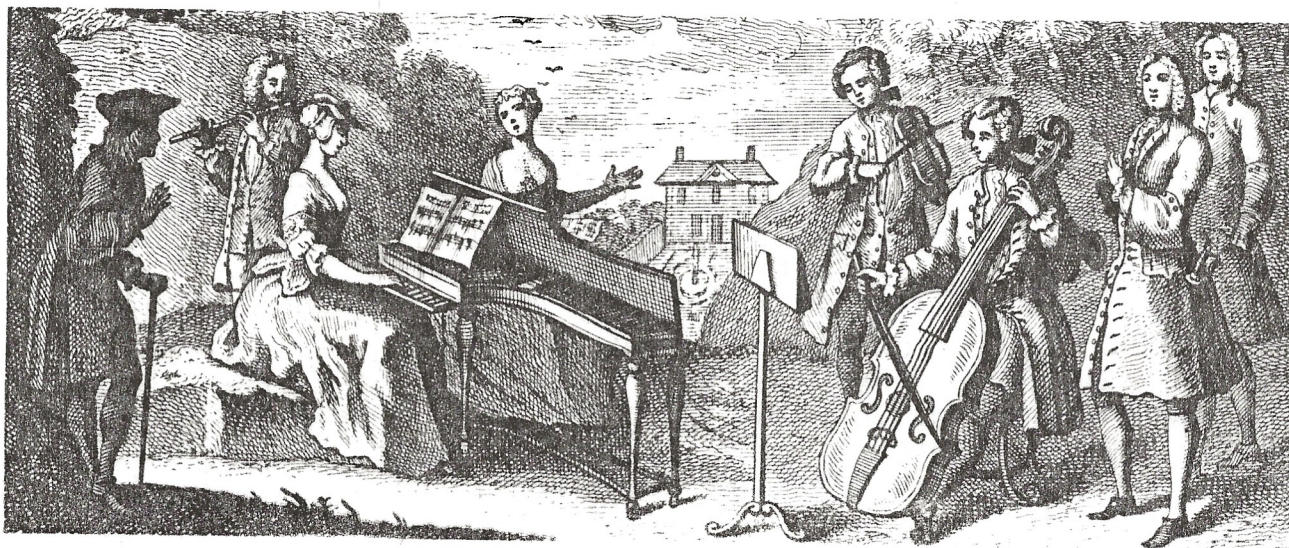
