The first time that young musicians came up to this location was in 1942 when the Long Beach All-City Junior High Orchestra came up for a weekend outing. The property belonged to F.J. Schinnerer, Mrs Ohlendorf's father. The group returned the following year and by 1944 two sessions were established - one for Junior High and one for High School. By 1946 the sessions were lengthened to two weeks.

In late 1948 a bulldozer came to get rid of the old buildings, to establish the new. The orchestra bowl was constructed the following year. In 1952 the two girls' cabins added as well as the band bowl, and in 1954 the trolley appeared. These buildings remain unchanged. Ten years later a series of new buildings was constructed for the 25th anniversary, including the staff building, the "O" building and the swimming pool.

Other improvements have been made since then, including the establishment of Arrowbear Music Camp as a Non-Profit Educational Corporation with its own Board of Directors. All of these and more have contributed to making Arrowbear what it is today - the oldest and finest music camp in the Western United States.

In 1937, FRED CHLENDORF came to Long Beach Unified School District as a music teacher. That first year he organized an All-District Orchestra. For forty-five years Mr. Ohlendorf has presented concerts with the All-District Orchestras consisting of Junior and Senior High School students. Fred Ohlendorf, or "Mr. O", as he is affectionately called by his students, received his education at Northwestern University where he played violin and viola. Since then he has served as music teacher in Chicago Heights, Illinois, Long Beach and as Music Consultant in Long Beach. Fred Ohlendorf has been honored continually for his efforts on behalf of the musical education of the youth of Southern California. On the occasion of his 45th year as Music Director of the All-District Orchestras, the Long Beach City Council made a Resolution to honor him and to recognize his accomplishments. He was also featured in an editorial in the Long Beach Press-Telegram. Fred Ohlendorf is a man who has brought music, beautiful music, to the ears of many and is a man who has brought out the musical talents in many which might have gone unrecognized.

EDNA CHLENDORF is the capable person working behind the scenes year 'round to keep Arrowbear going - answering phone calls, responding to letters and being responsible for the organizational details. Her generous and cheerful spirit are always felt and greatly appreciated by all who come in contact with her. Mrs. Ohlendorf earned a Bachelor Degree in piano performance from USC. She spent many years playing the organ in church and giving private lessons in Long Beach. She is a member of Nu Phi Epsilon, the Musical Arts Club, the Long Beach Symphony Guild and an Honorary member of the Long Beach Chapter of the Music Teachers Association of California. In September and October the Ohlendorfs will again fly to England to visit their son Rick and his wife Marion and also travel in Europe

STAFF
